**Scroungers numbers** running well. 35 bowlers last Saturday. Great to see many new bowlers getting amongst the Finalists.

**Wednesday Bowler numbers** averaging 80 - 90. The humidity still just hanging around but nearly at the change of season.

**Greens status:** Now nearly back to playing standard. Greenkeeper doing his best to get the greens back on track. Main problem now showing is the ERI disease (dark brown roots and dieback exacerbated by low light and poor drainage), which a lot of club's greens suffer at this time of year due to hot and humid weather. No real legal products to control this. I keep calling out for any members who wish to step up to assist or take over as Greens Director (subject to a Board decision). No one has offered yet so I will just continue.

Our Club needs to enhance its team of umpires, markers and measurers to ensure that an official is present at all our Championship and other competitive games.

We are seeking bowlers with approximately 3 years or more playing experience interested in becoming an umpire at Bongaree.

We currently have a team of new and very experienced Umpires, but need to increase our numbers to ensure that we can cover all competitive games.

Tutorials/ course will be held at the Kallangur Bowls Club as follows:-

Marker - Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May

Measurer - Tuesday 9th May

Umpire - Tuesday16th May

Laws - Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> May.

Please note that to become an accredited Umpire it will be necessary to complete all <u>four</u> courses. However, anyone wishing to become an official marker and/or measurer will be required to attend only the relevant tutorial.

These courses will give participants a greater understanding of the game and the Laws of the Sport of Bowls which in turn will enhance your personal enjoyment on the bowling green.

All new Umpires are mentored during their early official duties, and all umpires and interested parties meet regularly to discuss any problems they have encountered whilst performing their roles and to refresh their measuring skills and interpretation of the laws.







# **Bongaree Bowls Club Catering Team**


